

Elementary & Middle School

Kindergarten – 8th Grade

New Student Fee (Non-Refundable)

- \$35 per child

Enrollment Fee (Non-Refundable)

- \$255 per family
- *Returning families enrolling after April 15 will incur an additional \$100 fee.*

This fee secures class placement for your student(s) and covers school technology and annual capital replacement costs.

Student Outreach Activities, Resources & Supplies (SOARS) Fee

Non-Refundable

The SOARS fee covers student field trips, school-specific supply items, classroom assets, consumable resources, and grade-specific fees as outlined below:

- Kindergarten – 5th Grade: \$140 per child
- 6th Grade: \$290 per child
 - *(Includes a 3-year Chromebook maintenance and warranty fee of \$150)*
- 7th Grade: \$310 per child
 - *(Includes Outdoor Education course fee of \$170)*
- 8th Grade: \$180 per child
 - *(Includes Graduation fee of \$40)*

Tuition Breakdown

- Total Cost to Educate: \$10,345
- Congregational Grant: \$4,886
- Base Tuition: \$5,459

Base Tuition + Chromebook (6th–8th Grade Only): \$5,584

Chromebook Information (Middle School)

Families who choose to supply their own Chromebook must opt out of the school's purchase program during the enrollment process and provide a device that meets school specifications. Upon approval, base tuition and SOARS fees will apply accordingly.

Chromebook Ownership Policy:

- Students attending FILS middle school for three years will own the Chromebook at the end of 8th grade.
- Students attending for less than three years must complete a buyout:
 - After 1 year: \$250
 - After 2 years: \$125

If the cost of the Chromebook increases unexpectedly, an additional fee may be assessed.



Tuition Discounts & Financial Assistance

Sibling Discount:

A 10% tuition discount is applied to the base tuition for each additional child (2nd child and beyond) enrolled in Kindergarten–8th grade. (*does not apply to First Immanuel Lutheran Ministries staff*)

Refer-a-Family Program:

Current families receive a \$1000 tuition credit for each full-time family they refer to First Immanuel Lutheran School.

- The credit appears on the referring family's FACTS account during the second semester of the referred family's first year.
- If the referring family's last child has graduated, the credit will be issued as a check.

RaiseRight (formerly SCRIP):

RaiseRight allows families to purchase gift cards and prepaid cards used like cash at participating retailers.

- 85% of the revenue from purchases is credited to your school account.
- To enroll, please contact the OPT Director.

FIL Studentship Award:

This need-based financial aid program is available to all school families and is funded through First Immanuel's Guardian Angel Program.

- It is our promise that every family who wants their child(ren) to attend First Immanuel Lutheran School will be able to do so, regardless of financial situation.
- Applications are available in the Family Portal under the financial tab.

Choice Programs:

Need-based Choice Programs are available to:

- New families entering 4K (5 days/week)–8th grade
- Returning families entering 4K (5 days/week), Kindergarten, or 1st grade

Programs include:

- Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (for Wisconsin residents)
- Milwaukee Parental Choice Program (for Milwaukee residents)
